- The ambitious EU <u>research and innovation</u> framework programme (2021-2027)
- Horizon Europe Budget: <u>€95.5 billion</u> (including €5.4 billion from NGEU Next Generation Europe programme of EU for Recovery from COVID-19 crisis)





- Top-down topics contributing to EU policies
- Competitive projects (excellence, impact and implementation)
- Projects should provide new knowledge and innovative solutions to European challenges
- Involvement of end-users, patients, care givers, medical doctors, policy makers (↑ Impact).
- Disease agnostic topics , unless explicitly excluded in the topic, cancer is included
- Clinical trials can be funded
- Crosscutting issues: SSH, open science, gender in research
